Made from Fiano grapes, this wine has an intense nose of peach and thyme notes. A great food wine, with creamy character on the palate, fine acidity and incredible length.	
Sancerre Comte Lafond, Ladoucette 2015. Loire, France	£69.00
Ladoucette is one of the top Loire producers. This marvellous Sancerre is refined and elegantly balanced boasting an aromatic complexity of gooseberries and rhubarb. This wine is fresh and harmonious, with nicely focused green fruit character and an elegant mineral texture.	
Meursault Narvaux, Louis Jadot 2015. Burgundy, France	£88.00
This wine exhibits the typical Meursault roundness and approachability, with a pleasing crispness and nutty accents.	
Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru 'Les Perrieres', Domaine Jomain 2015. Burgundy, France	£175.00
Les Perrieres is a respected Premier Cru vineyard; the wines are focused and elegant with rich, yet flinty notes of nuts and stonefruit.

Notes of leather, meat and pepper all pair well with integrated bramble fruits and a fine grained tannin.		
Valpolicella Classico Superiore Ripasso, La Casetta 2016. Italy		£42.00
Confectured cherry, plum and berry fruits complemented by vanilla hints. A rounded and velvety smooth palate bursting with intense and complex flavours.		
The Chocolate Block, Boekenhoutskloof 2015. South Africa		£49.00
Dominated by Syrah and aged for up to 18 months in old French oak. Aromas of leather, spices, blackcurrant and ripe raspberry fruit. Harmonious and powerful on the palate, with a cocoa and pepper complexity.		
Quartz Reef Pinot Noir, Central Otago 2014. New Zealand		£58.00
The most southerly wine producing region in the world, Central Otago is home to some of New Zealand's most perfumed and delicate red wines. This Pinot shows cherry, raspberry, violet, plum and spice.		
Château Batailley, Pauillac 2011. Bordeaux, France		£99.00
Elegant blackberry, blackcurrant and truffle flavours with notes of cigar box, pepper and spices leading to hints of liquorice and earth on the finish.		
Château Lynch Bages, Pauillac 2008. Bordeaux, France		£290.00
Red and black bramble fruits greet the nose, followed by a creamy textured, rich yet beautifully balanced palate. This is a serious wine but the tannins are incredibly elegant and the gorgeous, crunchy fruit finish goes on and on.		
Opus One 2014. California, USA		£540.00
An extraordinary nose of violets, creme de cassis and spring flowers. Gorgeously pure, opulently full-bodied, with sweet tannins and superb concentration. It tastes like a top-notch vintage of ripe Bordeaux, but made in California.
